

EXAMINER REMARKS

Etudes

Far Away - Richert, Teresa

A beautiful etude presented and played with gentle notes all through. Good articulation to the melody notes and with fluent short phrases. Now try to hold on to the whole notes in left hand for full note values to prolong a warmer and richer sound, ie. hold the notes throughout the whole bar in this etude. A nicely paced ending to finish this piece.

Technical Tests

Quick response to keys and all the key patterns were identified and played with accurate notes. Well prepared.

List A

Burlesque in G Major - Anonymous

This piece began with a lively tempo and played with a graceful approach suitable for this piece. Good finger work in the fast 16th notes and now aim for a little more musical contrast between p and mf sound. This piece was memorized

fluently.

List B

Angelfish - Crosby Gaudet, Anne

A convincing piece performed and the angelfish was moving fluently and smoothly throughout the playing. Good control of the left hand over the right hand notes. Consider staying on the half notes for full note values consistently. This piece was memorized fluently also.

List C

Cranky Cat - Richert, Teresa

A well prepared piece performed and all the staccato notes were well coordinated in both hands. Good attention to bounce the staccato notes with a bright and firm sound in the forte passages. A confident performance presented today.
