EXAMINER REMARKS

Menuet en rondeau - Rameau, Jean-Philippe

A fluid performance featuring beautifully contoured phrases. The melody showcased a deep legato touch, and the accompaniment was appropriately detached. It was mostly seamless, with the potential to refine the hand position shift from measure 8 to measure 9 (there was a small hesitation today). Other than that one detail, this was a highly polished performance with excellent dynamic contrasts.

List B

Allegretto - Bartók, Béla

An exquisite performance, Maxie. The cantabile style melody was projected so robustly, which contrasts so nicely with the gentler colouring of the pentatonic scale. Subtle mood shifts were portrayed beginning at measure 11. Try playing the piu mosso at measure 19 a little quicker as there was not an obvious change today. Also, can the pianissimo dynamics be even softer? These small details would simply be the "sprinkles on the cupcake" of an already exceptional performance -

brava.

List C

Invention in A Minor - Silvester, Frederick

A well-balanced conversation between the hands. The phrasing was finely nuanced, and there were beautiful dynamics present. Another highly polished performance, delivered with artistic command beyond the performer's young age.

Technical Tests

Patterns were mostly secure, with only minor inconsistencies and one missed key signature today. All scales were contoured expressively. Solid triads were robust and broken featured a smooth legato connected, with a quick recover after the hesitation.

Etude

Etude in C Major, op. 261, no. 3 - Czerny, Carl

A light dance with such tidy scalar passages. Try not to halt the forward motion by delaying the down beat at measure 13. Overall, a beautiful performance.
