EXAMINER REMARKS

List A

Burlesque in G Major - Anonymous

A lively dance tempo with stylistically detached quarter notes. Your dynamic contrasts were well prepared. You could add more pulse on the beat ones to highlight both the Baroque dance style and the phrase structure. You could also add more rise and fall to the phrase lines to give more contouring. Steady and secure.

List B

Angelfish - Crosby Gaudet, Anne

A flowing performance with clean and even eighth note finger work. The LH melody can be even more pronounced on the first page by keeping the RH more subdued. Listen that the pedal is always clearly changed at the indicated markings as there were some blurry textures today. A lovely ending.

List C

Cranky Cat - Richert, Teresa

You show good understanding of the conversation between the hands in this invention. The staccato could be a bit lighter 'up touch' to avoid a heavy sounding cat, but you kept it insistent right to the end. The sixteenth notes were precise and this was a fun performance.

Etudes**Heavenly Blue - Gerou, Tom**

An atmospheric performance with some lovely musical shaping developing. I particularly liked the slight rit at m 16. A musical performance.

Technical Tests

Your scales and triads show secure preparation and secure key knowledge just e natural form was played in RH instead of LH today.

Rhythm

Be sure to tap a steady beat with your foot WHILE you clap the rhythm as stated in the 2015 and 2022 syllabi.
