EXAMINER REMARKS

List A

Harlaquinade - Krebs, Johann Ludwig

Good coordination between the hands and pleasantly flowing phrases Good articulation in the right hand sixteenth notes. For a more stylistic performance, you could detach left hand eighth notes. Further, provide progressive direction towards a grand climax for optimum listener satisfaction.

List B

Sonatina in A Minor, op. 94, no. 4: I - Biehl, Albert

A comfortable allegro moderato tempo selected as the score suggests. Sensitive and musical moments throughout. A sad yet tender start surrounding the minor A key resulting in a good effort to interpret. Scalic passages presented with character while the melodic line was effectively projected. Hands effectively balanced as I could see that you took care to keep the left hand accompaniment soft in the background. Locate the grand climax and ensure it is presented effectively.

List C

The Song of Twilight - Nakada, Yoshinao

A well thought out entrance. I like the way you took the time to think and prepare before entering. A tender touch and expressive presentation. Well interpreted. Good use of the pedal; However, strive for even more clarity. Well balanced hands. I could see you enjoying the music. You truly presented a serene and enchanting twilight. A gentle and sensitive end. Further minor refinements needed for optimum expression and touch.

Technical Tests

Scales well prepared. Formula pattern well learned. Chromatic scale left hand good. Strive for a steady rhythm in scales and broken triads. Generally, well prepared.

Etude 1

Left Alone - Grill, Joyce

A slow and sad atmosphere created here, as the title implies. A good effort to balance the melody and accompaniment with the one hand. A tender melodic line presented. Good work. You entered the phrases at bar 13 ever so sensitively. The very low d in bar 17 was a bit heavy for me today. Otherwise, well interpreted. Few minor refinements in touch would enhance.

Etude 2

Bike Ride (Linda Niamath) A bright and vibrant bike ride. Surely a sunny and happy day. You created this lovely atmosphere. Articulation was good. However, strive to keep hands neatly coordinated to enhance your presentation.
