Technical Tests

Scales were secure and well known in the requested major and minor keys, try to keep them always even and steady. Triads were secure, solid had full tone and broken was fluent, quite rhythmic.

Etude

Celebration - Crosby Gaudet, Anne

A bright and cheerful performance sounding fun filled and happy for this celebration. Accents were well projected and this remained quite steady. Work for even more contrast and a little faster tempo now. Good pedal work.

List A

Burlesque in G Major - Anonymous

This was played with fine energy and effective contrasts. Try to release slur endings lightly without accenting. Well chosen tempo for Allegretto. 16th notes are emerging well. A happy performance.

List B

Mist - Poole, Clifford

A lovely rendition, good pedalling with shaping of phrases coming along well. You can pace the rit. and hold the final fermata longer. This was a wonderfully musical performance.

List C

Teapot Invention - Markow, Andrew

Happy spirit in the playing with 8th notes quite even and steady; staccatos had an energetic bounce. Now have fun with dynamics and create sounds to show off the teapot even more. Known well with a poised ending.
