EXAMINER REMARKS

List A

Allemande in G Minor, BWV 836 - Bach, Johann Sebastian

Suitably buoyant approach with stylistically detached articulation. Fine range of contrasting tonal levels with wonderful tempo management. Sensitively tapered ending and fine rhythmical direction throughout remaining phrases also much appreciated.

List B

Allegro moderato in F Major - Mozart, Leopold

Generous landscape of dynamics & contoured phrasing beginning to emerge quite nicely. Quarter notes can project even more to enhance your fine technical control of the energetic alternating sixteenths in the harmony.

Brown, Timothy - Meditation in the Rain -

Relaxed and reflective atmosphere for this dreamy precipitation theme. Mature tempo and tonal nuances captured the emotional intent most poignantly.

Etude 1

Prelude, op. 39, no. 19 - Kabalevsky, Dmitri

Hands tightly aligned at a suitably brisk tmepo through a very good spectrum of tonal colour. RH staccatos can project more throughout.

Etude 2

The Black Pony - Papp, Lajos

A most engaging presentation for this diminutive dark horse! LH staccatos through melody measures 5-20 projected most effectively with impressive story telling expression. Intro and coda carefully pedaled.

Technical Tests

Scales secure with nicely tapered endings near minimum tempo. Continue developing a smooth tone to elevate these further. Solid V7 and arpeggios very carefully prepared.
