List A

Air in D Minor, ZT 676 - Purcell, Henry

Musical thought evident, which should be commended as it is nice to see at such an early stage. Detached quarter notes were stylistic. Personally, I enjoy this element as it captures the essence of the era. Gentle phrase endings were lovely. Well interpreted. Steady and secure work. Minor refinements could enhance further.

List B

Alpine song--Steady and secure work. Strive to land the hands neatly at the start of each bar. Also, strive for clean pedal changes. More expression in the left hand at bar 17 would enhance. A lovely ritardando at bar 23 today. There is room for even more musical refinement. However, well interpreted at this early stage.

List C

Jazz Invention No. 2 - Gallant, Pierre

Observe suggested tempo. Strive for more enthusiasm and rhythm. Personal engagement would result in a more rhythmic and dramatic performance. Have fun!

Technical Tests

Scales requested known. Formula pattern was well learned. Chromatic scale in the right hand was accurate. Broken triads in the right hand were steady. Solid triads in the left hand were secure. Well prepared.
